Questions for Session Eight

1. During Peter's visit to the saints at Lydda whom did he encounter? What did the man need? How did Peter accomplish what the man needed him to do? What was the reaction of the people?
2. Who was Dorcas, and where did she live? What had she left as a legacy, and what had been her work? How did those in mourning contact Peter? Where was he?
3. Explain how Peter addressed the needs of (1) the paralytic in Lydda and (2) Dorcas who had lived in Joppa. How straightforward was his method for meeting their needs as individuals? How did the people react to both activities?

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
