Psalm 19, which is another one by David, teaches how the heavens declare the glory of God. There are several descriptive phrases, which when read aloud, help us to better understand the might and power of the LORD.

In what ways can Psalm 19 influence your own prayer life? In your studying Psalm 19, how would you alter your prayer life to reflect David's thoughts?

Thursday, March 11, 2021

1 Corinthians 1:18-25



In this letter to the people at Corinth we read that those, who have faith and have received Christ, clearly perceive the power of the cross. It also states that persons, who have not received Christ, think of the cross as foolishness.

What does this mean? Why would a Christian see the power of the cross of Christ, while a sinner would think of it as foolishness? Explain in some detail.
