**Monday, March 22, 2021**

**John 12:20-33**



Jesus teaches in v. 24 *unless a kernel of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains only a single seed. But if it dies, it produces many seeds.* While we can be saved—*unless we die to self*—we cannot live for Jesus.

Discuss this parable as it relates to your life here in the twenty-first century. What does it mean for you to produce many seeds? Explain.

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**Tuesday, March 23, 2021**

**Jeremiah 31:31-34**



In v. 34b the LORD continues to speak through the prophet, Jeremiah. He says he *will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more.*

What does it mean to for the LORD *to forgive* and *to forget*? What does it mean for each one of us *to forgive* and *to forget*, when others transgress against us? Caution: *It might not mean what you think!* Explain your ideas.

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**Wednesday, March 24, 2021**

**Psalm 51:1-12**



David clearly recognizes—*by his statement in v. 5*—that as a result of being human, he was guilty/sinful by association. He also recognizes the fact that we are capable of individual sins, and that we are in need of forgiveness for both.

What was David's prayer in vv. 7-12? How is David's language in this prayer *similar to* or *different from* your language as you pray for forgiveness? Explain.

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**Thursday, March 25, 2021**

**Hebrews 5:5-10**



Hebrews 5:7 teaches that Jesus offered up prayers with loud cries and tears to his Father in heaven, and that he submitted to the Father. Jesus taught us the value of learning how to be *obedient* in our suffering.

How can we learn from the experiences of Jesus? How can we learn to pray more effectively by being submissive to God? What does submission mean?
