**John 7:37-39**

**Psalm 104:24-34, 35b**



These verses from Psalm 104 (1) call us to worship and to praise God, (2) give us the *why* of praising God, and then (3) call us again to worship and to praise God. The importance of *why* is relevant to many people.

Why did the psalmist give us such a reason to praise God in this selection? Why did the writer choose *not* to call us to worship and to praise?

**Acts 2:1-21**



Vv. 2-5 include the experience of those present at Pentecost. V. 1 states that they were together when the Spirit came upon them.

Describe the scene. How were these people were empowered by the Spirit? Why do you suppose God chose this particular time and place to send the Holy Spirit upon these people? Explain the power that was released there.

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
