Romans 12:1-8



Paul writes that God’s grace is available, and that through his grace we will be transformed into people God can and will use for his purposes. He continues to explain that we have different gifts to be used for God’s kingdom.

How have you identified your giftedness, and what have you done with the gifts God has given you? How have you used your giftedness for his kingdom?
