Matthew 21:33-46

This scriptural passage is a parabolic teaching based on the story of a landowner, who planted a vineyard and installed a wine press. When it was time to collect his share he sent his representatives on his behalf.

What did the tenants do? How did they behave? Was it appropriate for the landowner to demand his share? Did the tenants do what was right? Explain.

Psalm 80:7-15

Psalm 80 is a teaching about the people, Israel, and how God brought them up out of Egypt—*much like someone would bring a healthy vine out to a rich and beautiful hillside*—only to have it under perform.

Why do you suppose the people were allowed to be overrun by everyone, who was passing by, and defeated by all their neighbors? Explain.

Isaiah 5:1-7

This teaching, in the first seven verses of Isaiah 5, tells a story about a man, who planted a vineyard, dug a wine press, and built a wall around it. He was expecting a good crop, but he only received sour grapes.

How has God planted his people in the promised land—*expecting a bumper crop of fruitfulness*—only to experience rejection?

Thursday, October 8, 2020



Philippians 3:4b-14

Paul relates his personal story to the hearer/reader in this passage from his letter to the church at Philippi. He teaches that he was a proud man, one who kept the law and upheld Judaism.

What happened to Paul to cause the change we see in this passage? Was this a transformational change? How did Paul respond to his encounter?
