Psalm 95:1-7a



The psalmist is extolling the reader/hearer to praise God by singing with joy and thanksgiving for the simple reason that the LORD is the great God and the great King above all gods.

When we consider our own personal and corporate celebration and worship of God, how might we be instructed by these verses? Explain.

Thursday, November 26, 2020

Ephesians 1:15-23



In Paul's letter to the Ephesians he praises them for their unwavering faith in the LORD Jesus and for their love of the saints. He continues to tell them that he always prays that God will give them a Spirit to know him better.

How do we pray that we will know God better? How do we pray that God will reveal his character more fully to us? How are we enlightened by prayer?
